Requirements for membership

<u>UNDERGRADUATES</u>: Undergraduate students must complete a minimum of 12 semester hours (4 courses) in History, earned in the classroom, online or through AP or transfer credits (or a combination thereof). A minimum GPA of 3.1 in History and 3.0 GPA overall are required. A student need not be a history major to apply.

<u>GRADUATES</u>: Graduate students should have a GPA of better than 3.5 and shall have completed approximately 30% [i.e., 3 classes or 9 semester hours] of program requirements for the Master's Degree.

Anyone meeting the above requirements is eligible for membership. **You need not be a history major to be a member of Phi Alpha Theta.** Persons whose GPA or unit counts falls below this minimum may be accepted with a recommendation from a CSUF faculty member and a review by the faculty advisor of the chapter. <u>Please return this form in an envelope</u>, filled out completely/legibly, to Dr. Robert McLain's Departmental Mailbox (H-815F) or mail it to Dr. McLain, CSUF Dept. of History, 800 N. State College Blvd., Fullerton, CA 92834 (or give it to Dr. McLain in person (in H-735M)).
